Optimal reagent performance should be determined by titration for each specific application. APC has an excitation max at 650 nm and an emission max at 660 nm.

BACKGROUND INFORMATION

Human CD79B (Igβ, B29) is a 36–40 kDa type I transmembrane glycoprotein expressed on B cells. It forms a heterodimer with CD79A to constitute the B-cell receptor complex, mediating antigen-triggered signaling that regulates B-cell development and activation. Containing an extracellular Ig-like domain and a cytoplasmic ITAM, CD79B is essential for BCR signaling. Mutations cause agammaglobulinemia type 6, and it serves as a diagnostic marker and therapeutic target for B-cell lymphomas.
